Software Competition Rules

This competition is open to both international as well as national participants.

Eligibility Criteria:

In order for a person to participate in this competition, he/she must be enrolled in an undergraduate/post-graduate degree program or have completed his/her Under-Graduate/post-graduate studies on or after January 1, 2017.

TEAM DETAILS:

- A team/group may consist of minimum 1 and maximum 4 members.
- Each member of a group must fulfill the eligibility.
- All members of a group must be the students of the same institute.
- At least one member of each group must be available at any time during the competition at the entry display of that group.
- No team is allowed to bring their own flex.
- Display of shields or awards are not allowed.

REGISTRATION:

Registrations will entail the submission of the following:

1. A filled registration form, submitted online
2. A document that contains the design and applications of your software
3. A prototype of the project

Registration/Entry Form:

Registration form is only available on the SOFTEC **website** (<http://www.softecnu.org>) at the registration link of the software Competition. The form must be filled and submitted online to get your identification number on your email address.

A description of the complete software must be emailed after registration. The details of the description are as follows

Software Document:

You are required to send us a document that contains the following information regarding your project:

1. Abstract of your project (1-3 lines maximum)
2. Description of the project (Minimum 500 words - maximum 1200 words).

This section includes the information of what the project is all about, technologies and platforms used in this project.

3. Design of the application.

This section will contain the complete diagrams of system design and architecture.

4. Process Flow Diagram.

In this section, you have to provide a diagram, which will show the triggering event(s), sequential flow of process steps, decision points, and deliverable or outcome of a single process.

5. Applications of the system.

This section will contain the complete details of, where this project can be used, what are its benefits, and who are the targeted users of the project.

This document should be sent to sc@softecnu.org along with your registration reference number (rrn) received in the registration confirmation email.

Prototype:

- Email the prototype to sc@softecnu.org along with your registration reference number (rrn) received in the registration confirmation email.
- Any prototype not executing properly will not be considered for evaluation.

Prize Money:

The prizes for this Competition will be distributed as follows:

1st Prize	PKR 80,000
2nd Prize	PKR 40,000

HARDWARE ISSUES:

Participants within Pakistan should arrange their own hardware. All accessories, including the system, mouse and keyboard, should be arranged by the participants themselves.

If the International participants are unable to bring their systems, they are required to submit, in detail, the system requirements along with accessories for their software project.

Any requirements, such as hardware, network space, etc. must be stipulated during registration. Requests for additional materials at the time of the competition may or may not be entertained.

In case of a valid reason the SOFTEC Society may provide keyboard, power cables, mouse and monitor, subject to the availability of hardware.

In case of any damage to hardware provided by SOFTEC Society, participant will be responsible. Participants are requested to check in their hardware at the time of display and check out before leaving the display place. Otherwise SOFTEC Society will not be responsible for any loss.

COMPETITION SPECIFICS:

- All entries must be on display for the full 2 days of the event.
- The projects would be on display for general public and at least one member of a team is required to be there at ALL TIMES during exhibition to explain their project to the public.
- A panel of judges will evaluate each software project during the two- day period of the competition.
- Complete documentation of every software project, including the user manual, should be available at the time of evaluation during the event. No project will be evaluated without its documentation.
- The decision of the judges will be final.
- Participants are required to be there a t the time of e valuation. Failure in appearing before the judge at the time of evaluation will automatically disqualify the project from the competition.
- No team can leave the competition before the closing ceremony of SOFTEC even if that team fails to qualify for the second round.

IMPORTANT:

If a program is found to be a copy or replica of any other software, the act will be considered plagiarism and the participant will be disqualified.

In all matters concerning the competition, the decision of the SOFTEC Society will be final and binding on all concerned.

The SOFTEC Society reserves the right to disqualify any participant who fails to adhere to the above-mentioned rules.

The SOFTEC Society reserves the right to modify the rules without prior notice.
