APPENDIX: GENERAL INFORMATION FOR IDEAS XTREME PARTICIPANTS

Unfettered by the trappings of a tertiary-level education, children often see possibilities inconceivable to those of us with the more mundane obstacles of reality weighing heavily on our minds. Ideas Xtreme creates a forum for students to bring to the public purview their ideas of the uses of I.T. in the future.

In this competition, students are required to come up with wild, speculative projects concerning the application of I.T. in the future, demonstrating their ideas via a physical model. Winners are selected on the basis of how thoroughly thought out, beneficial, inventive, innovative and applicable in real life their projects are.

This extremely successful event was first launched in 2003, when the need for an event in the SOFTEC line-up to inculcate an understanding of I.T. in youngsters, as well as adults, was deeply felt. From an initial basis only in Lahore, this event grew to become a national event by SOFTEC 2004. Both years, this event won praise from the honorable minister of I.T., Mr. Awais Ahmed Khan Laghari.

Ideas Xtreme is a competition in which candidates can present their idea based on a specific theme decided by our team, through presentation using any presentation software rather than a model. Given their Idea must be practical and related to science/technology and participants must be able to relate their idea to benefits for people and or the change it could bring for the people, in short application of idea must be presented after presentation of ideas.

Theme for Ideas Xtreme: Healthier Pakistan

(Renewable energy, Water conservation, recycling, waste management, pollution management etc.)

Ideas Xtreme sees increased participation every year, and the SOFTEC 2017 event entertained over a hundred entries.

ELIGIBILITY

The categories of participation, as well as the prizes for Ideas Xtreme during SOFTEC 2018 are as follows:

Senior Wing (Grade 9-A levels/ Intermediate)

1st Prize Rs. 15,000 2nd Prize Rs. 10,000

Junior Wing (Grade 5-Grade 8)

1st Prize Rs. 12,000 2nd Prize Rs. 7000

The participants of a category should belong to the grade of the specified category.

Participants of any age group unto A-Levels/Intermediate can participate. (This competition is open only to Pakistani participants)

PARTICIPATION

- 1. Individual contestants are allowed.
- 2. A maximum of 2 members per team.

Rules and Regulations:

The participants/teams are required to present slides representation of their idea. Failure to do so will result in disqualification from the competition.

The idea can be displayed through any presentation software.

Presentations need to be emailed at <u>waleed_hussani@hotmail.com_</u>before the competition day.

The participants/teams will be required to bring their /slides on event day (presentation slides in any portable device).

An idea cannot be presented without any presentation software.

Ideas must be related to the theme

Time limit of presentation is max 5-7 minutes. And participants may be told to stop if they exceed their time limit.

One team can have maximum of 2 members.

Participants must bring their own USB drives and laptops.

Ideas must be presented explicitly and must be unique.



Plagiarism cases may result in disqualification of team.

SOFTEC's decision will be final and no objection can be raised by the teams regarding positions.

COMPETITION & EVALUATION CRITERIA

1. Evaluation Criteria:

Marks would be given on Presentation, Idea, its relevancy to the theme and its Applications in real life out of 30 by the judges. (10 marks for each for each category). There will be three rounds and the marks will be combined for all three rounds to calculate the final result, there will be no elimination round.

- 2. Participants MUST be present at the time of their evaluation. Failure to do so will result in disqualification.
- 3. **ACCOMODATION** will be provided ONLY to those participants who reside outside Lahore and they will be charged for this.
- 4. In all matters concerning the competition, the decision of the **SOFTEC Society** will be final and binding on all concerned.
- 5. Projects displayed at SOFTEC 2016 or earlier will not be allowed to take part in the competition.
- 6. The **SOFTEC Society** reserves the right to modify the rules without prior notice.
- 7. One team participant can only take part in one of the categories of competition.

4. Registration fee for the Ideas Xtreme Competition is **PKR 1000/- per team** and is **nonrefundable.**
